

The Clarion City Council met in regular session Tuesday January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023, at 5:00pm in the Council Chambers with Mayor Rod Heiden presiding. Present were Council members Andy Young, Dan Hennigar, Shayne Hennigar, Nick McOllough, and Dave Flurer. Motioned by S. Hennigar seconded by Young to approve Resolution (23-03) appointing Police Chief. All Ayes. (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by Flurer seconded by McOllough to approve Resolution (23-04) appointing City Attorney. All Ayes. (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by Young seconded by S. Hennigar to approve Resolution (23-05) approving Reimbursement for Housing Rehabilitation Project. All Ayes. (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by D. Hennigar seconded by Flurer to approve Resolution (23-06) approving pay request #4 with RoJohn Home Improvement for Daycare for \$8,103.24. All Ayes. (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by Young seconded by D. Hennigar to keep all Committee Assignments the same for 2023. All Ayes. (Motion passed 5-0).

Comments to the Council: One councilman mentioned he was approached about if the city ever thought of having a dog park. Discussion had, but no decision nor direction was made. Praise to the City Guys for their efforts taking care of the snow during these past couple weeks. Praise to the Ambulance Crew for their professionalism (Emergency call was witnessed by a councilman). It was mentioned the EMS teams in Wright County have been denied certification classes for new EMT's from ICC. We have the participants, so it was mentioned to contact Iowa University to see what they might offer.
