

The Clarion City Council met in regular session Tuesday September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, at 5:00pm in the Council Chambers with Mayor Heiden presiding. Motioned by Hennigar seconded by Flurer to approve consent agenda consisting of Minutes- 2025.08.19 , 2025.08.21 Special; Financial report- approve checks; Licenses/Permits- (Building, Liquor, Tobacco, Sign, Peddler, Street Closure) Liquor: Dollar General, Red Shed LLC ; Building: Chapman – shed, Rosenkilde - shed; Road Closure: CDA, CGD Schools (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by Flurer seconded by McOllough to approve Resolution (25-52) approving Pay Request #30 with Peterson Construction for WTP Project for \$24,700.00 (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by Flurer seconded by Ennis to approve recommendation from the Finance Committee to renew the Perpetual Care CD with First Citizens for 12 months at 4.15% (Motion passed 5-0).

Council had a discussion on future city capital projects. There were no firm decisions made but there were directives given to the City Administrator with plan to have the finance committee discuss before meeting again as a council.

Reports from the Council or Dept heads: Hennigar said there is an open house at the CDA spec building on Thursday.
