

The Clarion City Council met in regular session Tuesday April 2nd, 2024, at 5:15pm in the Council Chambers with Mayor Heiden presiding. Present were Council members Dave Flurer, Dan Hennigar, Shayne Hennigar, Nick McOllough and Mike Ennis. Also in attendance City Administrator Clint Middleton, Attorney Zach Chizek, PWD DeVries, and Chief TerHark.

Mayor Heiden called the meeting to order and polled the council for any conflicts of interest with the agenda, there were none. Mayor Heiden asked if there were any citizens listed to address the council, there was one. Shawn Devoid, presented a flier she created on "Clean-Up Clarion" (improper Trash and Recycling Storage) where she talked about 3 parts: Equipment/Collection, Education, & Penalties. This was sparked by her seeing trash being blown throughout town because of these issues. City will reach out to Trash Vendors to see if there are ways that trash collection days could be more consolidated. Alleviating the issue of trash being out for several days a week.

Motioned by Flurer seconded by S. Hennigar to approve consent agenda consisting of Minutes- 2024.03.19; Financial report- approve checks; Licenses/Permits- (Building, Liquor, Tobacco, Sign, Peddler, Street Closure) Building - Santiago (deck), Road Closure - Howieson, Bosch (Motion passed 5-0).

Nick Fredrickson (ISG) provided update on WTP project. Recommendation from the engineer is to approve Pay Request. Motioned by McOllough seconded by S. Hennigar to approve Resolution (24-10) approving pay request #12 with Peterson Construction for \$584,250 (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by Flurer seconded by McOllough to approve Resolution (24-12) Set PH date for Full Budget (Motion passed 5-0).

Motioned by D. Hennigar seconded by McOllough to approve Resolution (24-11) authorizing Annual Transfers Fy24 (Motion passed 5-0).

Comments from the Council or Dept heads: Concerns on some locations doing open burning, PD will be monitoring that area of town. Mayor commented on a couple properties with nuisance issues.

Motioned by D. Hennigar seconded by McOllough to adjourn. All Ayes. (Motion passed 5-0).
