

The Clarion City Council met in regular session Tuesday March 19th, 2024, at 5:00pm in the Council Chambers with Mayor Heiden presiding. Present were Council members Dave Flurer, Dan Hennigar, Shayne Hennigar, Nick McOllough and Mike Ennis. Also in attendance City Administrator Clint Middleton, Attorney Zach Chizek, PWD DeVries, and Chief TerHark.

Mayor Heiden called the meeting to order and polled the council for any conflicts of interest with the agenda, there was one (D Hennigar, Addition). Mayor Heiden asked if there were any citizens listed to address the council, there were none.

Motioned by D. Hennigar seconded by Flurer to approve consent agenda consisting of Minutes- 2024.03.05; Financial report- approve checks; Licenses/Permits- (Building, Liquor, Tobacco, Sign, Peddler, Street Closure) Building: Addition (Torsell), Fence (Wycoff) (Motion passed 4-0, conflict).

Heard from Ashley Bosch who is running for Wright County Supervisor. Ashley is big on community involvement, having been a past Rowan City Council Member. She is running in the district that includes part of Eagle Grove and all of Woolstock. (All voters in the county have an opportunity to vote for all candidates.)

Airport Fuel Farm Project was discussed giving the council members an update on where this project is and how we will need to move forward. Project has stalled and we have been in correspondence involving Contractor, Bond Company, Engineer, and City Attorney. D. Hennigar wants to make sure we push for fines from the project being over the due date. We will keep moving forward with the process that needs to be taken to get the project complete. This includes the possibility of having a 3rd party complete the project.

Comments from the Council or Dept heads: Needed to push harder on the clean up of the house fire on South 1st St. Questions on Gazebo Park items that may need updated prior to Festival.

Motioned by D. Hennigar seconded by Flurer to adjourn. All Ayes. (Motion passed 5-0).
