Motioned by Flurer seconded by S. Hennigar to approve Resolution (22-130) Authorizing Transfer Motion - Audit. All Ayes. (D. Hennigar Absent: Motion passed 4-1).

Comments from the Council: Young, discussed agenda for delegates from Kosovo that will be in town November 2nd. November 15th the Mayor (of our sister city Junik in Kosovo) will be in attendance for part of the meeting. After, the group will be attending a meal together. Flurer, mentioned we will have a nuisance committee meeting with a business this week and wanted clarification on expectations. Asked for an update on the streetlights in town, for both on the faulty and the purple hue. Jon will give an update when he is back. Police Chief gave a quick update on items that happen recently of a missing person and a robbery.
