

The Clarion City Council met in regular session Tuesday, September 17th, 2019 at 4:30 pm in council chambers with Mayor Duane Asbe presiding. Present were Council members Dave Maxheimer, Andy Young, Jim Williams, Teresa Lancaster, and Dan Hennigar.
